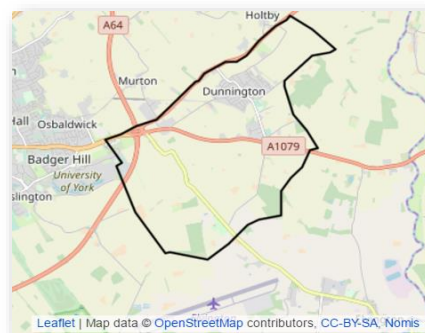


## Dunnington Parish Census 2011 Profile
